Terry Hicks Scholarship

The Terry Hicks Scholarship was established in 2008 and sponsored in full by private donor and former CFRC Board Member, Mr. Terry Hicks. The scholarship is specifically designed to enable single moms to continue their education at a post-secondary level. This scholarship will be awarded with a firm belief that given an opportunity through the life experiences of continued education one's life can be positively altered or impacted. Recipients will be eligible to receive this award until the completion of the desired A.A., A.S, certificate program or desired employment skills are obtained.

Eligibility Criteria

- Received acceptance into a post secondary level educational institution or accredited vocational program.
- Plan to enroll at a minimum of part-time student status.
- Priority given to single mother, age 21 (at time of initial enrollment) or younger.

Application Procedures

- Submit completed Scholarship Application form to Program Coordinator.
- Attach acceptance notification into post secondary institution.
- Attach a copy of your most recent tax return.
- Two letters of recommendation (teachers, employers or community leaders) mailed to: CFRC, Attn: T.H. Scholarship Fund, 851 Case Street, Hendersonville, NC 28972
- If selected as a finalist, will agree to a personal interview with the Scholarship Review Committee.
- If awarded, will agree to photos and or other printed publicity associated with the scholarship.

Examples of How the Scholarship may be used (but are not limited to):

- Tuition, books, uniforms, class materials and lab fees.
- Transportation to classes, bus/cab fares, auto repair, tires, gasoline
- Payment of childcare or a babysitter that will allow student to attend class.

Terry Hicks Scholarship

Selection Criteria

- Applications will be reviewed and scholarships awarded by a designated Scholarship Review Committee made up of members representing various organizations from throughout Henderson County including the public school system.
- A screening process of applications will result in the top candidates being invited for a committee interview.
- After interviews are conducted committee members will determine the scholarship recipient. All decisions by this committee are final.
- Annual award not to exceed \$1000.00 to any one applicant.

Renewable Standards

- The awards will be reviewed and evaluated based on the recipient's school attendance, level of effort and demonstrated desire to continue their education.
- Recipient will submit documentation of semester schedule/tuition or other financial support needed to continue their education to CFRC for processing.

Method of Payment

- All scholarships will be paid directly to the service provider.
